### **OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Subject: Sustainable Development through Cluster Approach under Component 3 of Bana Kaih (Handholding) Scheme.

The component of Sustainable Development through Cluster Approach under the Bana Kaih (Handholding) Scheme shall be implemented as follows:

- 1. Sustainable Development through Cluster Approach under the Mizoram Bana Kaih (Handholding) Scheme shall be implemented by Departments under the Agriculture & Allied sector in convergence with their existing on-going schemes. Departments under this sector are as follows:
  - a) Agriculture Department
  - b) Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Department
  - c) Fisheries Department
  - d) Horticulture Department
  - e) Irrigation & Water Resources Department
  - f) Land Resource, Soil & Water Conservation
  - g) Rural Development Department
  - h) Sericulture Department
- 2. Besides clusters in the Agriculture & Allied sector, the development of industries in cluster mode and through investment zones as per the Mizoram Sustainable Investment Policy, 2024 are encouraged and proposals under this shall be submitted by Commerce & Industries Department.
- 3. The construction of crucial infrastructures required in the clusters such as buildings, roads, electricity, water supply etc. should be planned in consultation with the concerned engineering departments.
- 4. Implementing Departments shall identify clusters considering the economic returns and the social impact that the project would have. The cluster could also be selected based on the multiplier effect that can be achieved when considered with other components of the Bana Kaih Scheme.
- 5. The project intervention under this scheme shall essentially be 'gap filling' in nature but not limited to it. Therefore, Detailed Project Report (DPR) shall be prepared by the proposing departments in convergence with their existing schemes and projects. Further, the on-going schemes and projects of other related Departments can also be built-in. In fact, the coming together of two or more departments in the preparation of the DPR is encouraged. For instance; Agriculture Department and Irrigation & Water Resources Department can come together for the sustainable development of a particular cluster. The format for the DPR is as per Annexure.

- 6. DPRs duly countersigned by the concerned Administrative Head of the Department shall be submitted to P&PID which will prioritize and recommend the same after due scrutiny.
- 7. If the project is recommended from the fund allocated under the Bana Kaih (Handholding) Scheme, the proposing department shall approach Finance Department for budgetary allocation, Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction as per extant rules. Besides this, P&PID may fit the prioritized projects under relevant schemes of Government of India, Ioan funds ( such as NABARD) etc.
